The Cambridge Clinical Research Facility (CRF) has been assisting the Cambridge BioResource in many ways, for the past 8 years.

CRF nurses have received informed consent and obtained blood samples from **1,319 volunteers** for the Cambridge BioResource **Stage 1** study.

CRF staff have conducted/facilitated more than **4.600 study visits** by volunteers on BioResource **Stage 2** studies (see table below).
