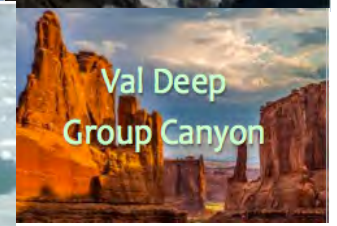
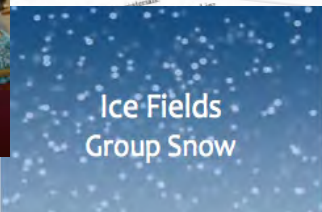
Room Layout

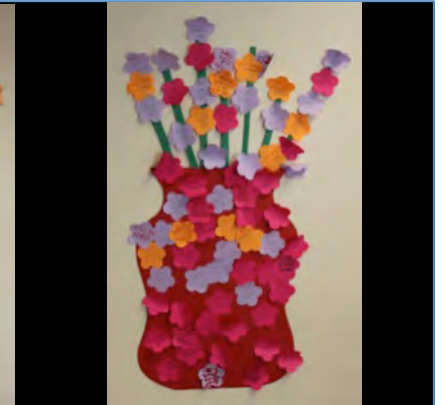
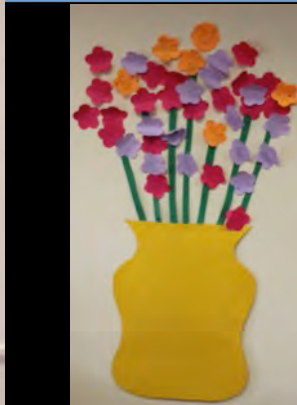
Monitors Role

• Prepare rooms near reception

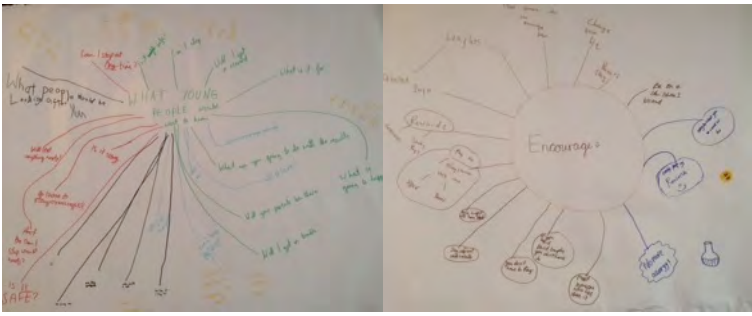

 ★ It's good idea to have entertainment at hospitals. It makes it more INTERESTING 😊



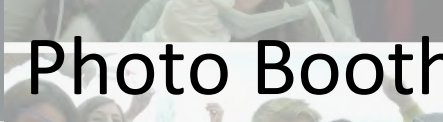
