

Introduction for Clinical Research Staff

Main components of day one:

- ▶ Ethics and the law in clinical research
- ▶ Research governance, including the role of R&D
- ▶ Data and information governance in clinical research
- ▶ Costing and funding of studies
- ▶ PPI and PPE

Main components of day two (Optional depending on role):

- ▶ Understanding and applying key concepts relevant to clinical research ethics, including HRA REC 'approval', consenting and recruiting participants
- ▶ Understanding key documents and study personnel roles in research
- ▶ Safety reporting in clinical research
- ▶ Practical tips for screening and recruiting participants
