

Introduction for Clinical Research Staff

A *two day* introductory course for clinical research professionals who:

- are new to working in a clinical research role
- have started in such a role on the Cambridge Biomedical Research Campus
- hold honorary research contracts or are CUH employees

Main components of day one:

- Ethics and the law in clinical research
- Research governance, including the role of R&D
- Data and information governance in clinical research
- Public Involvement and Engagement in Research
- Costing and funding for NIHR Portfolio studies

Main components of day two (clinical staff only):

- Understanding and applying key concepts relevant to clinical research ethics, including HRA REC 'approval', consenting and recruiting participants
- Understanding key documents and study personnel roles in research
- Safety reporting in clinical research
- Practical tips for screening and recruiting participants

- 27-28 September 2023
- 13-14 December 2023

N.B.: Please note that the course is not about the teaching of research design
